What are Olive Trees?

Olive trees are beautiful trees that do well in the Las Vegas Desert Environment. They not only handle the extreme temperatures but also grow well in our high pH, clay based soil. A fun fact about olive trees is that they can be a renewable energy! When burned, the wood produces 2.5 times the amount of heat compared to other trees and the smoke is harmless. The remaining ash can be used to fertilize gardens. Furthermore, the wood of an olive tree is resistant to decay. Olive trees can provide cooking, skincare, and spiritual purposes. The only drawback about Olive Trees is their allergy causing pollen and very messy fruit. However, Center Cut Landscape can help with both of these problems!



What's the Solution?

While newer olive cultivars are no longer fruit-producing, the older olive trees still do produce a messy amount of fruit. Olive trees typically flower in March or April. These flowers produce a pesky pollen that can fill the hot summer air. The fruit is produced throughout the summer and as it ripens it falls to the ground and will stain anything underneath including sidewalks and vehicles. Furthermore, the fruit attracts pigeons and other birds to the trees and your property. The staining power of the olives is not lessened by passing through these birds either.

The solution is to spray the trees with a growth regulator before the tree blooms. The best time to spray the tree is in February! The spray greatly reduces the flowers which helps eliminate the pollen and can eventually eradicate the fruit!
